Portion Updates:

Goats: still waiting for Lyra to kid, Luna was taken back to the billy for another try but jumped out after six hours so wait and see. Myrtle broke a back leg last Sunday, vet called out and put it in a cast for six weeks stall rest although she can be let into paddock for short spells on dry days.

Bees: 1 strong hive, 1 weak hive. Hives decimated by wasps at the end of last year, has been a problem for all beekeepers. Richard took one colony home to rescue, may be too close to return if it survives in which case another colony will need to be established. Garden: new patch coming along really well potatoes beans and permanent bed planted, work started on clearing black plastic from the bank in preparation for sowing and planting self seeding herbs and wildflowers. Neighbours at Highcliffe want to repair topmost timber retaining structure on our side and put a strip of black sheet between it and their fence to keep weeds from coming through to their side, agreed but best if they become members to be covered under our insurance while working on our side of the boundary structure.

Very little left in the top garden. Shed, picnic tables and polytunnel have been removed and are being reinstated in new locations. **Final team work party 11th May at the top** to tidy the site and remove last items ready for handover, Pauline to check tenancy termination terms.
